VostroNet rolls out its high-performance network for UniLodge, the largest purpose-built student accommodation in Australia and New Zealand with 15,000 residents across nine cities.

Case Study

VostroNet's relationship with UniLodge is a testament to the quality of infrastructure VostroNet deploys and its ongoing ability to provide a fast and stable internet experience for their students.

Facing inadequate connectivity from their incumbent provider, UniLodge sought out VostroNet to perform a full review of its portfolio of sites. Two major issues were identified: that the existing connections had inadequate capacity for the number of students living in each building, and the equipment (both wired and wifi) was out-of-date and incapable of delivering a stable and seamless internet experience.

Following this review, VostroNet was commissioned to deploy internet to UniLodge's latest site, a 280-bed residency at Charles Darwin University.

The site design included installation of the latest Wi-Fi mesh access points to ensure total site

coverage in each building. The location of each access point was selected following thorough investigation, including the conducting of heatmap simulations for complete coverage.

With a successful deployment and a satisfied resident base, UniLodge subsequently commissioned VostroNet to retrofit the internet facilities at their very first and anchor accommodation building, UniLodge Sydney in Ultimo, before rolling out to a further 20 buildings across Brisbane, Sydney, Melbourne and Auckland.

UniLodge continues to work closely with VostroNet today, and with UniLodge naming future-proof internet infrastructure as a critical priority for their upcoming sites, this relationship will continue to grow in the future.

VostroNet utilises its industry-leading technology to deliver an unrivalled experience for end-users and aims to build further partnerships with the developers and managers of multi-dwelling units.
